## AGENDA ITEM 3. OFFICE MANAGER'S REPORT

Mrs. Fitzgerald presented the Treasurer's

Report for November 2023.

Mrs. Fitzgerald reported on the Lovingston sewer project. Rural Development (RD) sent a letter to DEQ and the Native Indian Tribe for the area (Delaware Nation) on the environmental side in which they have 30 days to provide their final comments. The Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) has been submitted to the Richmond office of RD and it states the project will cost \$2,235,000. We are pursuing the maximum grant available at the lowest interest rate and hope to hear something soon about funding.

Mrs. Fitzgerald reported that CHA has approached the County Administrator about setting up a scoping meeting also with the

Service Authority to understand the needs that the County will have at the Larkin Property. They have asked for a brief description of what is planned for that site in order to prepare the evaluation efficiently and effectively. As of today, a meeting has not been scheduled.

Mrs. Fitzgerald stated that she and Jeff Brantley, NCSA Foreman met with the Jeremy Marrs, Nelson County E&S Coordinator in reference to the Henderson's Store site owned by the County of Nelson as a location to dispose of dredged materials from the Black Creek Reservoir. Everyone was in agreement this site would accommodate the needs of the Service Authority and is less than an acre in size. The County of Nelson Board of Supervisors at their December 12, 2023 meeting gave permission for NCSA to use this site for the dredged material.

Mrs. Fitzgerald informed the Board of Directors of the Administrative office closure dates for the upcoming holidays.
